1. Heard.

The appeal CRA No.1945/2022 (Rajesh Hemla vs. State of Chhattisgarh), preferred by the appellant against the impugned judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 01.12.2022 by engaging counsel of his own choice has already been admitted on 12.12.2022, is pending consideration before this Court and thereafter, the instant criminal appeal i.e. CRA No.165/2023 (Rajesh Hemla vs. State of Chhattisgarh) has been
