1. Challenge in this writ petition is to the impugned order Annexure P-1 dated 28.12.2022 whereby service of petitioner has been transferred from Veterinary Hospital Khadgawan, District Koriya to District : Gaurella-Pendra-Marwahi.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is suffering with 42% permanent disability and in support thereof, Unique Disability ID Card of petitioner is annexed alongwith writ petition. According to circular issued by State Government, disabled persons are to be posted at the place which is easily approachable and direct conveyance facilities are available, however, at transferred place of posting of petitioner direct conveyance facility is not available. Wife of petitioner is also Government employee and posted at District -Koriya. Petitioner already submitted representation on 17.01.2023 before Director, Veterinary Services and thereafter another representation on 23.01.2023 before the Committee constituted under Transfer Policy, but till date same is pending consideration. Grievance of petitioner would be redressed if direction be issued to the concerned Committee to take decision on pending representation of petitioner at the earliest within specified time.



3. Learned State Counsel submits that as petitioner is not pressing this writ petition on merit, he is having no objection to the limited prayer made by counsel for petitioner.
4. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused documents annexed alongwith writ petition.
5. Considering fact of the case, nature of grievance, limited prayer made by counsel for petitioner and not opposed by State Counsel, without entering into claim of petitioner, writ petition is disposed of at this stage directing the Committee constituted under Transfer Policy to take decision on pending representation of petitioner dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within an outer limit of '**three weeks**' from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
