**ORDER**

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner submits that looking to the nature of claim made by petitioner in the writ petition, petitioner may be permitted to submit fresh representation before Respondent No. 2 and in turn Respondent No. 2 be directed to consider and decide the same within specified time.

Considering the submission of learned counsel for petitioner, facts and circumstances of the case, without entering into merits of the claim of petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of permitting the petitioner to submit a representation before Respondent No. 2 and if such a representation is submitted, Respondent No. 2 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, expeditiously preferably within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of representation.
