No.1/2023 - Application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the Appellant.</p> <p>Vide Judgement dated 9.2.2023 passed in Sessions Trial No.18/2016 by the Additional Sessions Judge, Durg, the Appellant stands convicted under Section 324/34 of IPC and has been sentenced to undergo R.I. for 7 months & fine of Rs.10,000/- with default stipulation.</p> <p>Taking into consideration the short sentence awarded to the Appellant and also considering the fact that the Appellant has already remained in custody for a period of almost two months, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case where the Appellant deserves to be released on bail during pendency of the Appeal.</p> <p>Accordingly, the I.A. No.1/2023 is allowed.</p> <p>It is ordered that in case the Appellant furnishes a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court then the execution of the substantive jail sentence awarded</p>



to him shall remain suspended during pendency of the Appeal and he shall be released on bail for his appearance before the concerned Trial Court on **27.4.2023** and thereafter he shall continue to appear there on all such subsequent dates as are given to him by the Trial Court in this regard, till disposal of the present Appeal.

List this Appeal for final hearing in due course.
