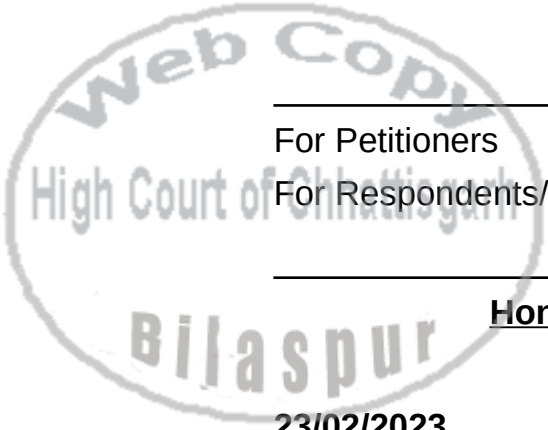

Order On Board**23/02/2023**

1. Grievance of petitioners is that the services of petitioners on the post of Rojgar Sahayak (Contract) is not renewed after November, 2022.
2. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners are engaged as Rojgar Sahayak since 2016 and appointment of petitioners was renewed from time to time. Lastly appointment of petitioners on the post of Rojgar Sahayak was renewed on 23.08.2022 for a period of three months i.e. from August, 2022 to November, 2022. Petitioners though continuously worked on the





said post and place where they were appointed vide order dated 23.08.2022, but further renewal order has not been issued by respondent No.3. He submits that petitioners have submitted representation before respondent No.3 on 23.11.2022, however, till date no decision has been taken on the same.

3. Learned State counsel submits that from pleadings and the documents enclosed it is apparent that grievance of petitioners is against respondent No.3 to whom he is not representing.
4. I have heard learned counsel for petitioners and perused the documents placed on record.
5. Considering the submission of learned counsel for petitioners, facts and circumstances of the case and the documents placed on record, this petition is disposed off at this stage directing respondent No.3 to take decision on the representation submitted by petitioners on 23.11.2022 in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks.
6. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of with the aforesaid observations.
