



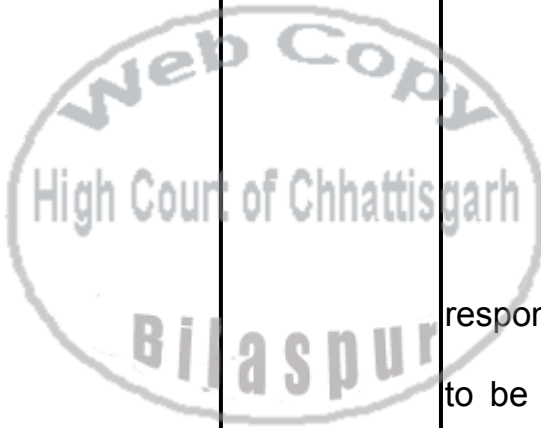

pursuant to order dated 18.10.2022 passed by this Court in WPS No.6555/2022, petitioner submitted representation before the Committee constituted under Transfer Policy, 2022 and the Committee without considering the grounds raised in representation in an objective manner, recommended to reject petitioner's representation in a casual and mechanical manner. He submits that based on interim protection granted to petitioner by this Court vide order dated 18.10.2022, he is still working at his present place of posting.

Considering submission of learned counsel for petitioner, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that effect and operation of transfer order dated 30.9.2022 (Annexure P-5), so far as it relates to petitioner herein, shall remain stayed till next date of hearing.
