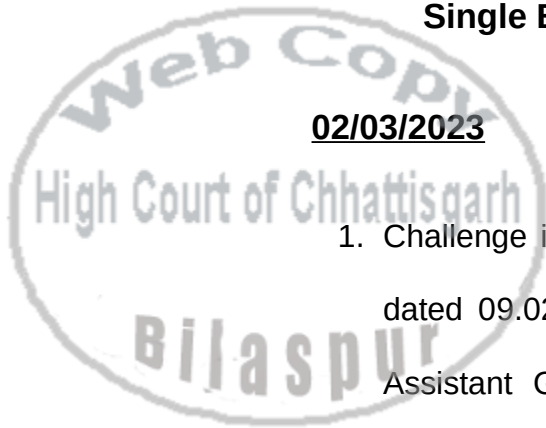

ORDER

1. Challenge in this writ petition is to the impugned order of transfer dated 09.02.2023, whereby, petitioner who is holding the post of Assistant Grade-II and posted at the office of Collector, Land Record, District Durg, is transferred to the office of Collector, Land Record, District Khairagarh-Chhuikhadan-Gandai.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner after raising multiple grounds, submits that petitioner may be permitted to submit a representation before the Committee constituted by the State Government under the Transfer Policy, 2022 and the said Committee be directed to consider and decide the representation of petitioner at the earliest.
3. Learned State counsel submits that he has having no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for petitioner.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
5. Taking into consideration facts and circumstances of the case,





submission of learned counsel for petitioner, I find it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition at this stage, permitting the petitioner to submit a representation raising all the grievance before the Committee constituted under the Transfer policy dated 12.08.2022, within a period of two weeks from today and if such a representation is filed, the concerned Committee is directed to decide the same, within a further period of **four weeks** from the date of receipt of representation.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, writ petition is disposed of.
