Shri Sudeep Agrawal, the learned Deputy Advocate General representing the State submits that the Petitioners are not justified in approaching the Court challenging the Rules insofar as the channel of promotion of the Petitioners who were holding the post of Data Entry Operators is entirely different. Shri Prafull N. Bharat, the learned counsel enters appearance on behalf of some interested parties who want to join the /is by filing necessary intervention applications and submits that there is absolutely no basis or merit for the claim. The Petitioners being the employees working in the technical cadre, now want to move into the non-technical cadre claiming promotion, despite the fact that they are having separate channel of promotion. It is also brought to the notice of this Court of that the 1st Petitioner has already obtained promotion in his channel as the Assistant Programmer and as such, the writ petition filed challenging the Rules, in spite of such promotion and without disclosing these facts, is not liable to be entertained.
