Accordingly, the application (I.A. No.1) is **allowed**.

It is directed that in the event of arrest of the appellant, in connection with the aforesaid offence, on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 50,000/-** to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, he shall be released on ad-interim bail.
