15/07/2021	Heard Shri Awadh Tripathi, Adv. for the appellants, Shri Vikram Sharma, Dy. Govt. Adv. for the State and Shri Ramakant, Assistant Solicitor General for the respondent No.4. Learned counsel for the appellants would submit that in view of clause (i) (b) of Annexure-I of the Chhattisgarh School Education Services (Educational and Administrative Cadre) Recruitment and Promotion Rules, 2019, the advertisement for recruitment of Teachers issued by the State Government vide Annexure – A/4 could not have prescribed the qualification of CTET [Central Teacher Eligibility Test] pass, as the same is not permissible because under Section 2 (a) read with Section 23 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, TET [Teacher Eligibility Test] conducted by the appropriate Government is the CG TET [Chhattisgarh Teacher Eligibility Test] and not the CTET. Issue notice to the respondents.



Shri Vikram Sharma, learned Dy. Govt. Advocate would accept notice on behalf of the State/respondents No.1 to 3.

Shri Ramakant Mishra, learned ASG would accept notice on behalf of the respondent No.4.

Let additional set of writ appeal along with its annexures be supplied to Shri Ramakant Mishra, learned ASG.

On the request of learned counsel for the respondents, four weeks time is granted to file return.

As prayed, post the matter in the week commencing from 16th August, 2021.
