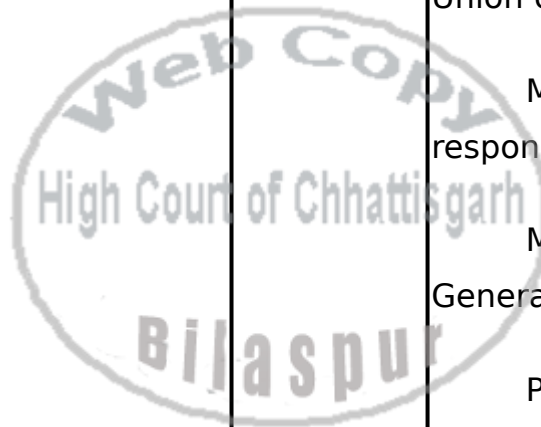

Kamta Prasad **Versus** State Of Chhattisgarh



18/08/2021	Proceeding through video conferencing. Mr. Awadh Tripathi, counsel for the appellants. Mr. Sudeep Agrawal, Dy. A.G. for the State/respondent Nos. 1 to 3. Mr. Ramakant Mishra, Assistant Solicitor General for Union of India/ respondent No.4. Mr. Sudeep Agrawal, learned Dy. A.G. appearing for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 prays for time to file return. Mr. Ramakant Mishra, learned Assistant Solicitor General appearing for respondent No.4 also prays for time. Post the matter after three weeks. At this stage, Mr. Awadh Tripathi, learned counsel for the appellants submits that after this appeal was entertained and notices were issued on 15.07.2021, the Director Public Instruction, Chhattigarh, has issued instructions to Divisional Joint Director and District Education Officer to expedite the process of appointment and complete the same by 25th August, 2021. He would submit that if the entire appointments are made, there would be complication and the appeal may be rendered infructuous. Since the appointment of about 14000 Teachers are to be made under the subject recruitment, we are not inclined to stay the whole appointment, however, to





secure the interest of the appellants, it is directed that for the present 12 appellants, 12 posts be kept vacant.
