Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per Annexure-P/3 an amount of Rs.3,01,163/- was due against various people including the present petitioner. The respondents in his proceeding dated 17.12.2018 has clearly indicated that certain amount has already been paid by the petitioner and the remaining amount has to be paid by some other employees. She further submits that because of the No Dues Certificate has not been given by the respondents and the petitioner has been deprived of the pension as well as other retiral dues.</p> <p>On the last date of hearing the State was granted time to seek instructions.
