Although the arguments were heard on 13-06-2022 for final disposal of the matter, the respondent side has brought to the notice of this Court the order dated 25-03-2022 by which this Court has passed the order on objection regarding the territorial jurisdiction raised by the respondent side, directing the parties to file affidavit within a period of 7 days.
