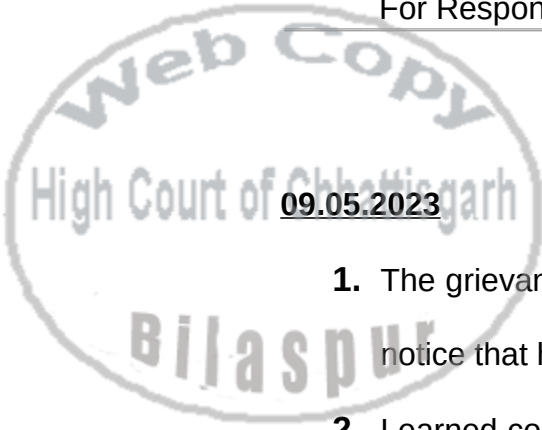

1. The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition seems to be the notice that has been issued vide Annexure P/1 dated 12.12.2022.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the said notice, the construction which the petitioner was raising has been stopped and he has already approached the respondents No.3&4 vide representations dated 14.12.2022 and 23.02.2023, however, there seems to be no decision as such taken by the respondent authorities.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents No.3&4 submits that since the petitioner himself has fairly stopped construction and his representation/objection is already pending before the authorities concerned, the authorities shall take an appropriate decision on the said application at the earliest.
