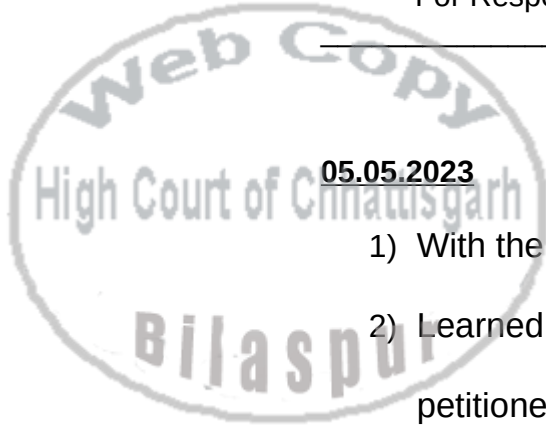

- 1) With the consent of the parties this matter is heard finally.
- 2) Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that similarly situated petitioners have filed a writ petition bearing WPS No. 4644 of 2022 and other connected matters which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 21.02.2023 directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner. Therefore, in the light of order dated 21.02.2023 passed in WPS No. 4644 of 2022 and other connected matters, this petition may also be disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to the concerned authorities which would be decided within a reasonable period of time.
- 3) Learned counsel for the State submits that the issue involved in the present petition is similar to that of issue involved in the writ





petition which was disposed of vide order dated 21.02.2023 passed in WPS No. 4644 of 2022 and other connected matters.

- 4) Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
- 5) In view of the submissions made here in above, this writ petition is also disposed of in terms of order dated 21.02.2023 passed in WPS No. 4644 of 2022 and other connected matters and the petitioner is at liberty to submit a representation before the respondents No. 1 & 2 within a period of four weeks. On such representation being submitted, respondents No. 1 & 2 shall consider and decide the same expeditiously keeping in mind the prevailing situation at the time of submission of options by petitioner at that relevant point of time.
- 6) With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
