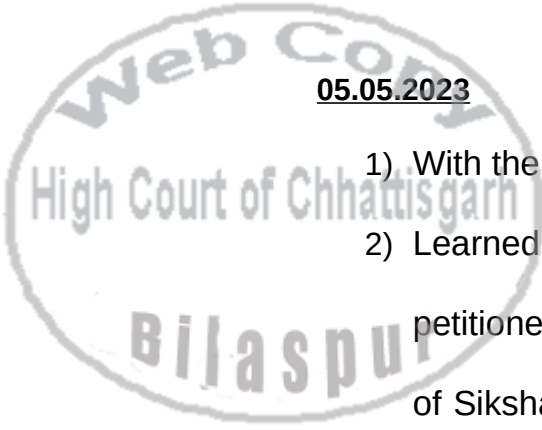

- 1) With the consent of the parties this matter is heard finally.
- 2) Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that initially the petitioner was appointed after due selection process on the post of Sikshakarmi Grade-III vide order dated 27.05.2005 with effect from 01.05.2005 thereafter again by due course of selection he was appointed on the post of Sikshakarmi Grade-II vide order dated 16.07.2007, the petitioner has claimed in this petition to grant revised pay scale. He further submits that the similar issue has already been decided by this Court in WPS No.2530 of 2017 and other connected matter vide order dated 28.11.2017, therefore, the representation of the petitioner Annexure P-5 may be decided by he respondents in light of judgment passed in the case of Mukesh Kumar (Supra).





- 3) Learned counsel for the State submits that the representation was submitted to respondent No.2 and it is the respondent No.2 who will decide the representation.
- 4) Be that as it may, this Court is inclined to dispose of this petition with liberty to petitioner to submit a fresh representation ventilating his grievances as projected in the writ petition to respondent No.2 within a period of 4 weeks and respondent No.2 shall decide the same within a further period of 12 weeks from the date of production of submission of such representation. In light of judgment passed by this Court in case of Mukesh Kumar Patel (Supra) and communicate the same to the petitioner.
- 5) With these observations, the writ petition stand disposed of.
