Heard on I.A. No.01/23, an application for grant of Ad-Interim/Temporary bail.

The present application has been filed for grant of temporary bail to the applicant who has been arrested on 17.10.2022 in connection with Crime No.179/2022 registered at Police Station Jaijaipur, District Sakti, CG for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 419, 439, 120-B, 34 of IPC.

Learned counsel for applicant submits that his father namely Rupchand Chandra died on 08.05.2023 and there is no male member in the family to take care of the last ritual ceremonies required to be performed on the death of his father. Therefore, counsel for applicant prays that the applicant may be enlarged on temporary bail. In support, he has submitted the certificate issued by the Gram Panchayat, Sonadula regarding the date of death of applicant's father.

Learned State counsel, has not opposed the said application.



Taking into consideration the fact that the applicant's father namely Rupchand Chandra died on 08.05.2023 and there is no male member in the family and the last ritual ceremonies are required to be performed by the applicant, I am therefore inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail temporarily.

Accordingly, the present temporary bail application i.e. I.A. No.01/23 stands allowed. It is directed that subject to the applicant furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court, he shall be released on temporary bail for a period of only 6 days starting from 16th May, 2023 to 21st May, 2023 with a condition that he shall positively surrender before the concerned trial Court on 22nd May, 2023. In between, the applicant shall not in any manner try to influence any of the prosecution witnesses nor would leave the territories of the District Sakti and the trial Court shall intimate the Registry of this Court about the surrender of the applicant.
