25.05.2023	Mr. Rajesh Kumar Kesharwani, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Raghvendra Pradhan, Addl. Advocate General and Mr. Rahul Jha, GA for the State. Dr. Sourabh Kumar Pande, counsel for the respondent/CGVYAPAM. From records, it is reflected that respondent No. 2 has issued an advertisement on 17.09.2021 for recruitment on post of Sub-Inspector, Subedar & Platoon Commander for 975 posts and the petitioners have filed the writ petitions for publication and declaration of category wise rank list including the category rank of in-service employees working with the police department. The petitioners have also prayed that the authorities may kindly directed to grant 5% reservation exclusively meant for employees of police department. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the State authorities have not followed the reservation rules in its letter and spirit and there is a lot of discrepancies in conducting the recruitment process. On the other hand, learned State counsel would submit that the prayer clause made by the petitioner at paragraph 10.1 in WPS No. 3336/2023 is rendered infructuous as the lists have already been published wherein the petitioners have not secured merit position in the examination, therefore, they have not called for further selection process. Learned counsel for respondent/CGVYAPAM supports the submission made by learned State counsel.



I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the documents place on records.

The submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners is required to be examined by this Court, therefore, the writ petitions are deserved to be admitted for hearing, accordingly, they are admitted.

Also heard on application for grant of interim relief.

Considering the submission made by learned counsel for the parties, let the selection process be completed in accordance with law and if the petitioners succeed in the petitions, the State will create supernumerary posts for considering their case for appointment.

The State is also directed to file return in every case individually wherein they will specifically reply to the grievance raised by the petitioners in each cases.

List these cases on 12th July, 2023 along with WPS No. 3363 of 2023.
