Heard on IA No. 01 – application for grant of interim relief. Counsel for the petitioner and respondent No. 2 submits that the FIR has been registered against the petitioner under Sections 408, 409, 418, 420 and 120-B of the IPC. He further submits that the dispute is with regard to some monitory transaction between the petitioner and the respondent No. 2. However, despite made a payment after receiving certain materials but then also he has claim for payment and on that dispute the FIR was lodged. Since the FIR is dispute of civil nature, the parties have entered into a settlement outside the Court therefore, the FIR may be quashed. Counsel for the respondent No. 2 submits that though the FIR was lodged by him, the amount due against the petitioner has been received by him and therefore, they have also entered into an agreement for settlement. Therefore, counsel for the petitioner and the respondent No. 2 submits that the statement of petitioner and respondent No. 2 may be recorded in terms of settlement. As prayed, the parties shall remain present before the Registrar (Judicial) on 21.06.2023 for recording their statement. Matter be listed after recording the statement on 04.07.2023.
