Let reply be filed within two weeks' both on merits as also on interim application. Heard on I.A. No.1, which is an application for grant of interim relief. Purely as an interim measure, taking note of the fact that disqualification of the petitioner was not on the ground that petitioner does not have proper degree but the disqualification seems to be on the ground that NET Examination cleared by the petitioner is not from CSIR in the concerned subject. However, taking note of the fact that NET Examination that the petitioner has cleared is from Agriculture Scientist Recruitment Board and certificate issued clearly reflects that the same has been duly recognized from the UGC and also from the CSIR vide their respective letters dated 04.10.1999 & 02.07.2003, prima facie a strong case for grant of interim relief has been made out. Accordingly, the respondent authorities are directed to keep one post of Assistant Professor (Zoology) vacant till the next date of hearing.
