1. Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner was appointed on the post of Computer Operator on Daily Wage Basis vide order dated 05.03.2012 and since then he is continuously working on the said post. Petitioner, after completion of more than 10 years of his working as Computer Operator on Daily Wage Basis, submitted a representation before respondent No.2 for his regularization in service, against sanctioned post, however, instead of considering the claim of



petitioner and deciding the representation submitted by him, respondent No.4 has issued advertisement for appointment on different posts and therefore, a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide pending representation of the petitioner dated 19.12.2022 expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the State would submit that he is only representing the State and claim of the petitioner is against respondent No.2.
3. Considering the nature of claim of the petitioner, submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is continuously working for 11 years as Computer Operator and also submitted application for regularization on the post of Clerk, which is pending consideration before respondent No.2 since 19.12.2022, without observing any thing on merit, this writ petition at this stage is disposed of directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation of the petitioner dated 19.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of order passed by this Court.
4. Petitioner will be at liberty to enclose copy of writ petition with annexures along with copy of order to be placed before respondent No.2.
