10.2 That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondent No. 3 & 4 to forward the report of petitioner to the Prison Review Board under the Rule 358 of Chhattisgarh Prison Rules 1968 for his consideration for remission under Section 432 of CRPC.

10.3 Any other relief, which this Hon’ble Court may deems fit and proper may also be awarded to the petitioner including the cost of the petition.”
