1. Grievance of petitioner in this writ petition is of non-consideration of his name for promotion on the post of 'Assistant Grade -II'.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner, who is holding the post of 'Computer Operator/Data Entry Operator' became eligible for consideration of his name for promotion on the post of 'Assistant Grade -II', but his name has not been considered for promotion. Aggrieved by which, petitioner submitted representation on 10.02.2023 before respondent No.3, which till date is not considered and decided. Hence, a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the pending representation at the earliest within specified time.



3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 submits that as petitioner is not pressing this writ petition on merits and only seeking direction to respondent No.3 for deciding the pending representation, he is having no objection. However, he submits that if the representation submitted by petitioner is not yet decided, it will be considered and decided in accordance with law.
4. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
5. Considering facts of the case, nature of grievance, submissions of counsel for the respective parties, without entering into merits of claim of petitioner, writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.3 to consider and take decision on pending representation dated 10.02.2023 (Annexure P-4), in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within an outer limit of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of this order.
