The present MCC has been filed seeking modification of the order Annexure A/3 dated 17.04.2023 passed by this Court in WPC No. 1753/2023. The modification sought for is seeking insertion of four more khasra numbers in respect of the grievance of the petitioner, which inadvertently got left out, even though the number was specifically mentioned in the writ petition.

Learned counsel appearing for the NHAI, so also the State Government have expressed their no objection so far as the modification to the extent of leaving of the khasra numbers those which were reflected in the writ petition.

For the aforesaid reason, the present MCC stands allowed. The order dated 17.04.2023 passed in WPC No. 1753/2023 stands modified to the extent in paragraph No.3 in addition to the khasra number already mentioned, the khasra No. 381, 383, 384, 386 shall also be read as part of the same.

The MCC accordingly stands allowed and modified. The order passed in the present MCC is directed to be made part of the writ petition WPC No. 1753/2023.
