30.06.2023, therefore, this Court is of the considered opinion that she should be released on temporary bail for a period of one month.

Accordingly, IA No.02/2023 is allowed and it is directed that on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court or CJM or Remand Magistrate (whomsoever is available), the Applicant be released on **temporary bail** and continue the same till 31.07.2023. She shall also furnish an undertaking that she shall surrender positively on 01.08.2023. While furnishing the bail bond, she and the person who gives surety shall also submit their copy of Aadhar Cards and photographs.

Post the matter for final hearing on **28.07.2023**.
