28.06.2023	Shri Lakhan Singh Bhadoriya, counsel for the Applicant. Shri Shreshtha Gupta, PL for the State. Heard on admission. Admit. Call for the case diary as also the criminal antecedents of the Applicant, if any. Also heard on IA No.01/2023, an application for grant of interim/temporary bail. The Applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.30/2023 registered at P.S Bilha District Bilaspur for the offence under Sections 294, 506, 323, 147, 148, 149 and 302 IPC. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that grand mother of the Applicant has died on 21.06.2023 and her last rites (<i>dasgatra</i>) will be held on 30.06.2023 where the presence of the Applicant is necessary and a certificate issued by Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat to this effect is enclosed herewith, therefore, his prayer for grant of interim bail may be considered. Per contra, learned State Counsel has opposed the prayer. Taking into consideration the submission of learned Counsel for the Applicant and further considering that the Applicant's presence is necessary



at his grand mother's last rites, therefore, this Court is of the considered opinion that he should be released on temporary bail.

Accordingly, IA No.01/2023 is allowed and it is directed that on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court or CJM or Remand Magistrate (whomsoever is available), the present Applicant be released on **temporary bail** for a period commencing from **29.06.2023 to 04.07.2023**. The Applicant shall also furnish an undertaking that he shall surrender positively on 05.07.2023. While furnishing the bail bond, he and the person who gives surety shall also submit their copy of Aadhar Cards and photographs.

Post the matter for final hearing after 4 weeks.
