1. Heard on application under Section 378 (4) of CrPC for grant of leave to appeal against acquittal.
2. Learned counsel for the complainant / petitioner submits that the complainant was able to prove the case beyond reasonable doubt, however, learned trial Court dismissed the complaint case and acquitted the respondent from the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act which is absolutely perverse and contrary to the records.
3. Considering the submission and perusing the documents appended with the application, the application for grant of leave to appeal is allowed. Leave is granted.
4. Registry is directed to register the case filed by the complainant as acquittal appeal and be listed for further orders.
5. The CrMP is accordingly finally disposed off.
