1. In terms of the order dated 30th November, 2023, Status Report has been filed on behalf of the State, wherein the fact of death of the grandfather of the applicant has been verified.

2. In light of the above, this Court is inclined to grant interim bail to the applicant for a period of three weeks from the date of release, upon furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court and further subject to the following conditions:

- a. The applicant shall appear before the Investigating Officer (IO) once a week on every Saturday at 4:00 PM through Video Conferencing.
- b. The applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of



the Court.

- c. The applicant shall provide permanent address to the Trial Court. The applicant shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the IO concerned regarding any change in residential address.
 - d. The applicant shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing.
 - e. The applicant shall provide all mobile numbers to the IO concerned which shall be kept in working condition at all times and shall not switch off or change the mobile number without prior intimation to the IO concerned.
 - f. The applicant shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with any of the prosecution witnesses, or any member of the victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case or try to intimidate any witnesses in the case.
3. The applicant shall surrender immediately after the expiry of three weeks from the date of release.
 4. Copy of the order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
 5. Accordingly, the application is disposed of.
