1. In terms of the order passed by this Court on 16th October, 2023, the learned APP has handed over the Report of the Child Welfare Committee (CWC), Faizabad dated 4th December, 2023, along with supporting documents and the same are taken on record.
2. As per the Report filed by the CWC, Faizabad, proper financial arrangements have been made for the well-being and financial support of the minor child of the applicant in the present case.
3. Mr. Sarvesh Awasthi, CWC, Faizabad, submits that necessary forms and formalities have been completed in terms of which a sum of Rs.4,000/- per month shall be paid to Smt. Satyam for the upkeep and upbringing of the

minor child.

4. Smt. Satyam, who is present in Court through video conferencing, is satisfied with the same and submits that she does not want any part of the earnings of the mother of the child (applicant herein) to be provided to her.

5. In these circumstances, CWC, Faizabad, is requested to take steps so that the aforesaid amount of Rs.4,000/- per month can be released in an expeditious manner.

6. Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, shall follow up with Smt. Satyam and Mr. Sarvesh Awasthi, CWC, Faizabad, with regard to expeditious release of the aforesaid amount.

7. In light of the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is satisfied that adequate steps and measures are being taken by the CWC, Faizabad, for the upbringing of the minor child. Accordingly, there is no need to keep the present petition pending and the same is disposed of.

8. Copy of this order be sent to the District Magistrate, Ayodhya, so that the aforesaid amount can be released expeditiously.
