1. The learned counsel for the petitioner/Garima Jain prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file additional documents, as prayed for. Response thereto, if any, be filed by the respondent/Rohit Jain within a period of two weeks thereafter.
2. The petitioner/Garima Jain, who is also present in person, submits that the closest route for the bus transport provided by the school is Route no. 10 and 11. She further submits that she would require a cab service/ auto for picking up and dropping the child from the bus stop to her place. She submits that, in case, the respondent/Rohit Jain is willing to bear the charges for the same, the child can travel to the school by the said mode. She submits that as



she was not in a position to drop the child to school, the child had to miss the school on a few days.

3. The respondent/Rohit Jain, who is present in person, submits that he is always willing to bear these charges.

4. In view thereof, the school be requested to provide the bus service to the child for pick up and drop at a place near the residence of the petitioner. The charges thereof, including the charges for the cab/auto shall be borne by the respondent.

5. The petitioner shall also inform the respondent through the counsel, the charges that would be payable for the cab service/ auto for picking up the child and dropping the child from the residence of the petitioner till the bus stop, along with proof of such charges in form of quotation, etc.. The respondent shall bear the same by depositing the amounts for the same directly to the cab service/auto service provider.

6. List on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2024.

7. It is made clear that no further adjournments shall be granted to the petitioner.

8. A copy of this Order may be communicated to the school by the respondent/Rohit Jain.
