**CONT.CAS(C) 1107/2023**

1. This is a petition seeking initiation of contempt proceedings for violation of the order dated 15.03.2023 passed in WP(C) 14502/2022 titled "*Habeebur Rahman vs. Municipal Corporation of Delhi & Ors.*". Paragraph 4 of the said order reads as under:-

"4. In view of the fact that though the owner/occupier has approached the Appellate Tribunal, MCD however, no stay has been granted, the present petition is disposed of alongwith the pending applications with a direction that the MCD shall take the requisite action expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from today."



2. Issue notice. Mr. Sabharwal, learned standing counsel accepts notice for the respondent.
3. Mr. Sabharwal, learned standing counsel states that appropriate action is being taken in accordance with the mandate of the Appellate Tribunal, MCD.
4. In view of the statement of Mr. Sabharwal, learned standing counsel, no further orders are required to be passed.
5. Mr. Sabharwal, learned standing counsel further states that in case the petitioner's property is found to be illegal and unauthorised, appropriate action shall be taken against the petitioner. The respondent needs no permission of this Court for the above.
6. If aggrieved, the petitioner will be entitled to avail all his legal remedies in accordance with law.
7. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of.
