CRL.M.(BAIL) 1679/2023

1. The present application has been filed seeking interim suspension of sentence for a period of 30 days on the ground that the applicant's house is in a dilapidated condition and accordingly, he has to carry out necessary repairs in his house.
2. The applicant has been convicted for the offences under Section 10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO) and Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (IPC) and has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 5 years.
3. In terms of the order dated 30th November, 2023, Status Report has been filed on behalf of the State, wherein it has been verified that the house of the applicant is in a dilapidated condition.
4. As per the Nominal Roll on record, the conduct of the applicant in jail has been satisfactory. The applicant has been granted interim bail earlier and he did not misuse the liberty so granted to him and had duly surrendered in

time.

5. In view of the above, this Court grants interim suspension of sentence to the applicant for a period of 30 days from the date of release, upon furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court and further subject to the following conditions:

- a. The applicant shall report to the Station House Officer (SHO) of the local Police Station once a week.
 - b. The applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
 - c. The applicant shall provide his permanent address to the Trial Court. The petitioner shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the Investigating Officer (IO) concerned regarding any change in residential address.
 - d. The applicant shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing.
 - e. The applicant shall provide his mobile number(s) to the IO concerned which shall be kept in working condition at all times and shall not switch off or change the mobile number without prior intimation to the IO concerned.
 - f. The applicant shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with any of the prosecution witnesses, or any member of the victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case or try to intimidate any witnesses in the case.
6. The applicant shall surrender immediately after the expiry of 30 days from the date of release.



7. Copy of the order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
8. Accordingly, the application is disposed of in above terms.
9. Copy of this order be given to the counsel for the applicant *dasti* under the signature of the Court Master.
