1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

**CRL.M.(BAIL) 347/2026**

3. This application under Section 430 read with Section 483 and 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of accused seeking interim suspension of sentence for a period of 20 days on the ground that his paternal uncle's daughter is getting married on 22.02.2026.



4. The application is opposed by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, who submits that the appellant/accused has criminal antecedents and, therefore, interim suspension of sentence for a period of 20 days may not be granted. However, if this Court is inclined to grant relief, the same may be restricted to a shorter duration.

5. Heard both sides.

6. As the appellant/accused is stated to have committed offences under the POCSO Act while he was on bail in the present case, interim bail a period of 20 days cannot be granted. However, in the interest of justice, the sentence is suspended for a period of two days.

7. The Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to release the appellant/accused on 21.02.2026 by 5:30P.M., and he shall surrender before the authorities concerned on 24.02.2026 by 5:30 P.M.

8. The application is disposed of.



9. A copy of this order be communicated electronically to the Jail Superintendent concerned for information and necessary compliance.
