1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

CRL.REV.P. 1/2023 & CRL.M.A. 11/2023 (stay)

3. The present petition is filed under Sections 397 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (**CrPC**) for quashing of order dated 07.10.2022 (**impugned order**).
4. By impugned order, learned Trial Court has framed charges against the petitioners under Section 498A/304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (**IPC**).
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. The FIR was registered only on a suspicion that the dowry was



demanded by the petitioners

6. He submits that even as per the documents including the suicide note collected by the Investigating Officer, the deceased committed suicide on her finding that the husband is having an extra-marital affair. Only the vague allegations of dowry demand have been made. The investigation done and the evidence collected is not of such nature to even give a presumption of suspicion that the petitioners have committed any offence.

7. On petitioner taking steps, issue notice, by all permissible modes.

8. Learned APP for the State accepts notice.

9. Reply, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
