ORDER

These are petitions under Section 34 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, assailing arbitration award(s), passed in the year 2012.

In view of the urgency emphasised by learned counsel for the respondents on the last date of hearing, these matters were fixed for hearing at 02.30 pm today. However, learned counsel for the petitioner requests for an adjournment on the ground that the main counsel is unavailable. The lackadaisical approach of the petitioner is unfortunate, given that the matters were specifically fixed today for final hearing. It was incumbent on the petitioner to make any request for adjournment, in advance.

In the circumstances, learned senior counsel for the respondents has been heard for some time.

In the interest of justice, these matters are adjourned to enable the petitioner to address arguments subject, however, to costs of Rs.50,000/- payable by the petitioner to the Delhi Legal Services Authority (DLSA).
