**ORDER**

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**30.10.2023**

1. Petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the Respondents for administrative approval and Expenditure sanction for repair/renovation work of the House No.12, Type – VI, Maulana Azad Medical College Residential Complex in order to bring it in a habitable condition.
2. It is stated that the house in question has now been repaired/renovated and is in habitable condition. It is stated that the repair/renovation work has taken one year.
3. In view of the above, the grievance of the Petitioner no longer survives.
4. It is contended by the learned Counsel for the Petitioner that since it has taken one year to renovate the house in question, the Petitioner be not



charged the license fee for use and occupation of the house for the said period.

5. This Court, at this juncture, is not inclined to pass any orders on this aspect. However, it is always open for the Petitioner to give a representation to the Respondents which shall be considered by the Respondents within six weeks from the date of receipts of the application.

6. With these directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of along with the pending applications, if any.

7. It is made clear that this Court has not made any observations on the merits of the case.
