1. The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed on behalf of petitioner seeking the following reliefs:-

*"(i) the respondent No.1 to No.3 to release the pension and pensionary benefits to the petitioner,*

*(ii) the respondent no.4 to proceed appropriately to get its circular implemented by the R1 to R3, in the interest of justice and fairplay.*

*Any other relief/order/direction in the facts & circumstances may also be passed in the favour of the petitioner."*
