Mr. Rajeev Narayan, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that in view of the applicable judgments of the Supreme Court, the petitioner does not require sanction of the Chairman, Railway Board, as sought in his representation dated 22.01.2014. He seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition.

2. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to take such civil or criminal proceedings in respect of the alleged defamation as he may be entitled to in law. This Court has not examined the correctness of the contention recorded above, or made any observation with regard to the maintainability of merits of any proceedings which the petitioner may choose to file.
