1. In view of the present application, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-University places reliance on various clauses of the M.Phil/Ph.D. Regulation of [Ordinance 9(IX)] including Clause 9(g) to argue that a scholar shall reside in NCR during the first two years of his/her registration.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-University, therefore, submits that the petitioner is working in J&K and she is residing outside NCR.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner attended classes of initial two years through online mode on account of Covid-19 pandemic and therefore, at this stage, the requirement of residing in NCR in initial two years cannot be pressed by the respondent-



University.

4. Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances indicated hereinabove, this court under the special circumstances, without treating this order as a precedent, is not inclined to vacate the interim order dated 28.07.2023 and accordingly, the aforesaid application stands rejected.

5. The application is disposed of accordingly.
