Ramesh Kumar Gupta Vs. Bank of India

Present: Shri Brijesh Kumar Kesharwani, counsel for the appellant,

This is an application filed on behalf of the borrowers for directions to the Tribunal below. The learned counsel concedes that the amount has not been deposited in compliance of the direction of Hon'ble High Court given in Writ Petition No. 38733/2019. Still the appellant is seeking direction for expeditiously disposal of one stay application filed before the Tribunal below. The Tribunal below may consider the matter depending on the docket. The borrower is free to make a prayer before the DRT for expeditious disposal of the proceeding. But considering the facts of the matter, there is no requirement of any direction to be passed by this Tribunal in the present application. Accordingly, the same is disposed off with no order as to costs.
