Bank of India Vs. Anil Kumar Gupta

Present: Shri Maneesh Mehrotra, counsel for the appellant,

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that the Tribunal below has directed the parties to maintain the status-quo without assigning any reason and the matter is adjourned for one reason or other. The application filed for preponement of matter has also been rejected. Therefore, a direction be given for expeditious disposal of the S.A.,

It appears that the status quo order was passed on 15.12.2020 subject to operational on service upon the auction purchaser. It is not known, whether the auction purchaser has been served or not as yet, but he was not served till 27.07.2021. Be that as it may, but the matter is posted for 14.09.2021 just after six days from today.

Hence, at this stage of proceedings, I do not deem it appropriate to direct the Tribunal below for deciding the S.A. within the stipulated period, but in the facts of the matter, the Tribunal below is expected to decide the S.A. at the earliest and for that purpose, the short dates may be given. The counsel for the appellant may request on the next date before the DRT for this purpose. Accordingly, the Misc. application is disposed off. No order as to costs.
