:: ORDER ::

1. The Applicant Bank filed the present OA for the recovery of a sum of Rs.27,13,893/- towards Loan A/c.Nos.52302989 & 52382613 from the defendant with future interest @16.50% p.a. from the date of application till the date of realisation along with costs.
2. Summon served on sole defendant and was set ex-parte on 17.10.2024 as called absent and no representation.

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3. A perusal of docket proceedings would reveal that the case had been posted for applicant bank's evidence on (1)28.11.2024, (2)24.01.2025, (3)18.02.2025, (4)04.03.2025, (5)25.03.2025, (6)25.04.2025, (7)18.06.2025, (8)23.07.2025 and finally on (9)21.08.2025. Costs of Rs.1000/- imposed on 18.06.2025 and Rs.5000/- imposed on 23.07.2025. Despite these many adjournments and costs, the applicant bank did not bother to adduce evidence. Even costs were not deposited as per order dated 23.07.2025. As the applicant bank failed to evince any interest in pursuing the case, the right of evidence was forfeited on 21.08.2025 and matter was posted for orders.

4. The point that arises for consideration is:-

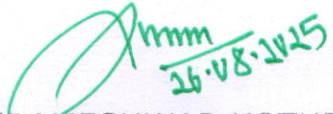
Whether the Applicant Bank proved its claim made in the OA against the Defendant?

5. As stated supra, the Defendant remained ex-parte and the right of adducing evidence of applicant was forfeited. The applicant bank failed to substantiate its claim by leading evidence and marking the documents inspite of several adjournments and costs. Under such circumstances, I hold that the claim of the applicant bank remained un-substantiated and not proved accordingly, OA is liable to be dismissed, without costs.
6. In the result, the present Original Application No.224/2024 fails and is hereby dismissed without costs.
7. Communicate a copy of this order to the parties concerned.

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8. Learned Registrar is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the Head of the applicant bank, both by e-mail as well as registered post.
