	<u>Present:</u> Mr.Dhruvkumar Chauhan, Ld. Counsel for the Applicant Bank. None appeared for the Defendants. Today, this matter has come up for hearing on the application vide I.A.No.2953/2024 for Application for paper publication. Ld. Counsel for the Applicant Bank submitted that this Tribunal has issued summons against the Defendants at their respective addresses to be served by way of RPAD. However, all defendants remained unserved and same has been returned with an endorsement of <i>"Item Returned Addressee Left Without Instructions"</i> as per the track reports. Postal Receipts and track reports has been produced before this Tribunal at Exh.A/5. As such, it is submitted that summons may be issued upon all defendants to be served through substitute mode of service. Considering the submission made by the Ld. Counsel for the Applicant Bank., this Tribunal deems it proper to direct the Bank to take steps afresh for service of summons to all the Defendants through publication in two daily newspapers i.e. vernacular and English, widely circulated in the concerned area. Hence, I.A.No.2953/2024 is allowed. Registry is directed to issue public notice/summons upon all the Defendants within seven days. Accordingly, I.A. No.2953/2024 stands disposed of.
