JUDGMENT

1. The case is taken on today's board for the purpose of Special drive and Lok Adalat as per circular of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court bearing No. B(Gen)-1001/2023/632 dated 01.04.2023 and letter received from DLSA, Mumbai vide O.W. No. 1155/2024 dated 21.09.2024. Accused is present before the Court. Particulars of the offence is read over and explained to the accused. Accused pleaded guilty voluntarily. His plea is accepted as voluntary. Accused prayed for leniency. Considering the submissions made by the accused and in view of Lok Adalat, I proceed to pass the following order:-

ORDER
