Sh. A.K. Bali, Advocate submits that earlier he was representing the accused Rohit Kumar as LAC in this case and now, the said accused has engaged a private counsel, therefore, he may be discharged as LAC from this case.

As Sh. Prashant Singhal, Advocate has appeared as the counsel for accused Rohit and has also filed the vakalatnama for the said accused, therefore, Sh. A.K. Bali, Advocate stands discharged as the LAC for the accused Rohit from this case. He will continue to represent accused Himanshu as LAC in this case.

PW/ACP Mahesh Kumar is absent despite being served.

Bailable warrant be issued against PW/ACP Mahesh Kumar, in a sum of Rs.5000/-, returnable on next date of hearing.

Witness cited at Sr. No. 2 in the list of witnesses, be also summoned for PE on 03.03.2025.

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At this stage, accused Rohit submits that he has not been provided proper medical treatment in jail despite several requests made by him.

Heard.

Concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to provide necessary medical treatment to the accused Rohit and if the same is not available in jail, he be taken to concerned hospital for the medical treatment and to file a detailed report in this regard on the next date of hearing.

Copy of this order be sent to DLSA, East and be also sent to concerned Jail Superintendent for intimation and necessary action.
