File has been taken up today on the interim bail application of accused Nitin Kumar.

IO/Inspector Rajiv Kumar in person.

Reply of the application has been filed.

Counsel for accused has submitted that no other bail application of the accused is pending either before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi or before any other court; that the accused is in custody for last 3 years and 4 months; that the grandmother of the accused is severely ill and wants to meet the accused; that the grandmother of the accused is emotionally attached to the accused because he is the eldest grandson; that the accused may be released on interim bail for the period of 30 days to take care of his terminally ill grandmother.

Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP for the State opposed the instant application arguing that the parents of the accused and his siblings are available to take care of the grandmother of the accused and important witness is under examination, who is likely to be influenced/threatened by the accused.

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Arguments heard. Record perused.

Admittedly, parents of the accused and his two brother are available in his family to take care of his ailing grandmother and therefore, this court is not inclined to admit the accused Nitin Kumar on interim bail. Accordingly, the instant application stands dismissed.
