

ORDER BELOW EXH. 4 IN
CRIMINAL BAIL APPLICATION NO. 5061/2023

Jitendra Kishor Pardeshi & anr.

Vs.

State of Maharashtra (Through Wanwadi Police Station)
(CNR NO. MHPU01-012737-2023)

1] Ld. Advocate for the applicants has argued that the marriage is solemnized on 7.12.2022. It is argued that since 6.5.2023 prosecutrix is living with her mother. The co-habitation period is hardly of 5 months. It is argued that applicants are husband and mother-in-law. General allegations are made against them. None of the allegations require custodial interrogation. There is strong apprehension of arrest. Hence, ad-interim protection be granted.

2] On perusal of FIR, prima facie, it is seen that the co-habitation period is hardly of 5 months. The allegations are of unlawful demand and physical and mental harassment. Prima facie, considering nature of allegations, none of the allegations require custodial interrogation. It is seen that except Section 498-A of IPC, all other sections are of bailable nature. Prima facie, it is seen that since FIR is registered, there is apprehension of arrest. It is proper to grant ad-interim protection with conditions. Hence, I proceed to pass following order :

ORDER

1. Application Exh. 4 is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest of Applicant Nos. (1) Jitendra Kishor Pardeshi and (2) Shobha Kishor Pardeshi are granted anticipatory bail in connection with CR No. 371/2023 registered with Wanawadi Police Station under Sections 498-A, 323, 504, 506 of IPC and they be released on execution of PB. in the sum of Rs.20,000/- each with one surety of the like amount.
3. The applicants shall attend the police station on every Saturday during 11.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. and otherwise whenever required by the I.O. till filing of the Charge sheet.

4. The applicants shall not, directly or indirectly, make an inducement, threat or promise to any persons acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.
5. The applicants shall at the time of execution of the bond, furnish their address and mobile number to the Investigating officer, and shall inform the change in residence if any.
6. Issue notice to the learned Public Prosecutor and Investigating Officer returnable on **16-08-2023**.
7. Copy of this order be served upon the Public Prosecutor and Commissioner of Police.
