**J U D G M E N T**

1. The accused named above has been sent up to this Court by the police of police station RPF, Amritsar for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 147 of the Railways Act.
2. Brief facts of this case are that the accused entered upon some part of railway without any lawful authority. The accused was arrested in this case. After completion of investigation, the complaint against the accused was presented in the Court.

3. On the presentation of complaint in the Court, the copies of documents relied upon by the prosecution were supplied to the accused as per Section 207 Cr.P.C. free of costs. At that time, the accused expressed his wish to confess his guilt. Before recording confessional statement of the accused, he was made to understand that his confessional statement could be used against him. Even then he stated that he wanted to get his statement recorded. On being satisfied that he wanted to confess his guilt without any threat, promise, inducement or pressure, the confessional statement of the accused was recorded. In view of the confessional statement of the accused, which has been proved voluntary, he is held guilty and stands convicted for an offence punishable under Section 147 of the Railways Act. Let he be taken into custody and be heard on the question of sentence.
