The matter is taken up out of turn at the request of counsel for the petitioner in view of the urgency expressed.

In the instant contempt petition, non-compliance of order dated 17th August, 2022 is being alleged by the petitioner against the respondents/contemnors in terms whereof the respondents came to be directed to allow the petitioner to appear in the final examination of 10th Semester of BA. LLB commencing on 22nd August, 2022 at his own risk and responsibility.

Statement of facts has been filed by the respondents/contemnors wherein it is being stated that the petitioner was not eligible to appear in the examination.

Mr. T. H. Khawaja, appearing counsel for the respondents/contemnors however would submit that notwithstanding the non-eligibility of the petitioner, the petitioner was allowed to appear in the internal component of the examination pursuant to the order of the court and in the event, the petitioner qualifies the said examination, the respondents/contemnors shall thereafter conduct a

special examination of the petitioner of the main component.
Statement of Mr. T. H. Khawaja is taken on record.

In view of the statement of Mr. T. H. Khawaja, the consideration
of the contempt petition is deferred till next date.
