02/13.07.2022 Heard learned senior counsel for the applicant and learned A.P.P. for the State.

This bail application has been filed on behalf of the abovenamed applicant with prayer to release on bail in connection with Radhanagar P.S. Case No.65 of 2022 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 307, 379, 504, 506 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajmahal.

Learned senior counsel for the applicant has submitted that the F.I.R. of this case was lodged against 13 named accused including the applicant with these allegations that all the accused persons after having formed an unlawful assembly armed with deadly weapon in prosecution of common object had assaulted to the informant and his family members. It is further alleged that in this incident, several people sustained injuries and one died on account of sustaining injuries.

Learned senior counsel for the applicant has submitted that in the F.I.R., no specific role of inflicting injuries to the deceased has been assigned to the applicant. It is further submitted that a counter case of the same occurrence was also lodged on behalf of the applicant's side against the persons of the informant's side which was registered as Radhanagar P.S. Case No.64 of 2022. The persons of the applicant's side had also sustained grievous and fatal injuries in that case. At this stage, it cannot be ascertained, who was the aggressor. The applicant has been languishing in jail since 24.03.2022.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the contentions made by the learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the submissions made and materials on record, the bail application of the applicant is hereby allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned in aforesaid case.
